Ofsted Update

As you know we were visited by HMI yesterday. It was an informal visit for half a day. I was really proud to show the inspector around the school and the children really were being very good. We talked about the children's learning and then spent an hour talking about our attendance data. The national attendance figure is 95.2% and our attendance is currently 94.2%. If attendance of the school is low, we are at risk of getting a poor judgment for 'Behaviour and Safety' which will stop us from being a 'good' school. Everyone is working so hard at Heathmere, it would be really disappointing for the school if we got a poor judgment because of attendance. I hope you now understand why I talk about attendance all the time – if your child is not in school they are not learning.
